MINUTES

Twin Lakes Township Wednesday, June 20, 2018 Town Board Meeting at the Carlton Fire Hall 5:30 p.m.

Board Chair Diane Felde-Finke opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. Other board members present: Supervisor John Vernon, Supervisor Randy Willie, Clerk Sue Chapin. Absent: Treasurer Stephanie Schmitz.

GUESTS:

MOTION to approve the June 6, 2018 minutes as printed was made by Willie and seconded by Vernon; all voted yes, the motion passed.

MOTION to pay all bills, check numbers #16686 - #16701 and electronic payment PERA18JUN for the total amount of \$35,730.44 was made by Willie and seconded by Vernon; all voted yes, the motion passed.

The board reviewed the treasurer's report.

OLD BUSINESS

- Water Line: Gilchrist is drafting a letter to send to property owners in the proposed water line district, to include in a mailing to them along with the SSD petition.
- Gillogly Road: A pre-construction meeting was held on Monday, June 18 at NCE. DesMarais with NCE has been in contact with a few property owners that had questions about tree removal.
- Fire Hall: The board reviewed updated Fire Hall floor plan options and cost estimate. There will be a Fire Hall Building Committee meeting next Monday.

NEW BUSINESS

- Fiber Optic: Fond du Lac Communications has requested a permit to bury fiber optic cable on Town Road 544 and Schmitz Road. MOTION to approve the Fond du Lac permit for fiber optic on Town Road 544 and Schmitz Road was made by Vernon and seconded by Felde-Finke; all voted yes, the motion passed.
- State Demographic Center: The 2017 annual estimates were received; our population estimate is 2,114, and our household estimate is 798.

ROAD MAINTENANCE

- Nendick Road: The Enbridge access was approved where it is, at an angle, utilitizing Enbridge's ROW; 100' to 150' from the road there will be a culvert. In the south ditch, Korienek is working on the trees and the property owner will improve the ditch. A new culvert is also going in just beyond the entrance to the ECE lift station. Class 5 will be brought in on the problem area.
- Overlie Road: Steve Olean will clean up the north ditch.
- Kortie Road: A chunk of blacktop where Kortie Road meets Jay West Road was taken care of.
- Jay West Road: There is new home at 1440, no driveway permit was applied for, a sub-par culvert was put in. Letter will be sent to the developer that any driveways must have a permit, and that aluminized culverts, of the type that are township and county approved, must be used.
- West Chub Lake Road/Hay Lake Road pond: A beaver was taken care of.
- Beaver: We need to hire a new person to take care of beaver. Olean recommends Dick Davidson, who took care of the beaver on the pond; his annual fee is \$300, which covers any beaver for the year. The board agreed to pay him \$50 for the pond beaver, and then pay him \$150 for the remaining six months of the year. MOTION to hire Dick Davidson to take care of beaver issues, at the annual amount of \$300, was made by Felde-Finke and seconded by Vernon; all voted yes, the motion passed.
- Cutting and patching: Olean talked to Kiminski about cutting and patching, he can take care of it at a good price. Felde-Finke will let Olean know to paint all of the spots that need work. Discussion on potentially hiring a new road worker to help with various road tasks; tabled for now.
- Scrub seal: The county indicated we could still possibly get in on scrub sealing this year, the board agreed to have Olean look into it, and at least get pricing.
- Evergreen Drive: Steve Olean did repair work on the guard rail.
