Emergency Town Board Meeting at the Historic Scott House
7:00 p.m.

Board Chair Diane Felde-Finke opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. Other board members present: Supervisor John Vernon, Supervisor Randy Willie, Clerk Sue Chapin. Absent: Treasurer Stephanie Schmitz. Also present: County Commissioner Mark Thell, Derek Wolf, and Reid LeBeau (by telephone).

OLD BUSINESS

- Water Line: Jenny Nash with the Minnesota House called the Clerk and said that our project will be in the House bill for \$7.5 million, the same dollar amount as in the Senate bill. The board reviewed information from Susan Wojtkiewicz with Donohue regarding potential savings to the current total project cost estimate. The board agreed that LeBeau should talk with legislators again and report back on whether anything more than the \$7.5 million could be worked out. If not, we will go with the \$7.5 million and work to bring the costs down; the board agreed that is feasible.

MOTION to adjourn was made by Willie and seconded by Vernon; all voted yes, the motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:27 p.m.
