Town Board Meeting at the Historic Scott House

Board Chair Diane Felde-Finke opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. Other board members present: Supervisor John Vernon, Supervisor Randy Willie, Treasurer Ginny Vernon, Clerk Sue Chapin.

MOTION to approve the October 21, 2020 minutes as printed was made by Willie and seconded by J. Vernon; all voted yes, the motion passed.

MOTION to pay all bills, check numbers #17485 - #17495 and electronic payment 941NOV20 for the total amount of \$46,871.39 was made by Willie and seconded by J. Vernon; all voted yes, the motion passed.

- Water Line: Information has been received regarding the requirements for receiving state capital grant payments.

- Roadside Mowing: We can have our mowing done later in the year; time frame will be determined next spring.

- Town Hall: Discussion on next steps; the board agreed that site prep should be done next year, and more details about the building itself will be looked at then.

NEW BUSINESS

- Enbridge: Enbridge will be doing maintenance work on their line and accessing the site from Lakeview Drive. The work will be done before the end of the year and will last about a week.

- Delinquent Sewer Invoices: **MOTION to authorize Carlton County to collect delinquent sewer charges plus late fees in the following amounts from the property taxes of Mary Ableiter Estate \$338.58, Robin and Harold Horner \$338.58, and Michael Pydynkowski \$338.58 was made by J. Vernon and seconded by Willie; all voted yes, the motion passed.**

- CARES Act: A resolution is required to receive CARES Act funding. **MOTION to approve a Resolution Accepting the CARES Act Election Grant was made by J. Vernon and seconded by Willie; all voted yes, the motion passed.**

- Driveway Permits: Permits were approved for Anthony Gillund, Meadow Lane, and for Timothy Young, Brook Hollow Drive. Culverts are required for both driveways.
